Born: May 29, 1913, Newcastle, Tyne & Wear, England.*

Died: July, 2001.

Although Ray made occasional appearances for his home town club, Newcastle, he had his best spell in the sport during a period at Hull in Division Three. Scoring 16 points from seven matches, Ray had a top score of seven at the Hedon Stadium against Cradley Heath in a National Trophy fixture. He was also an accomplished stock car driver and competed in several leading events around the country.
