

NEVIN, Edward (Ted)

Born: January 13, 1925, Pembroke, Dyfed, Wales.*

A popular and likeable second half rider at Liverpool, Ted was unable to make the step up into regular league action and was to make only two appearances for the 'Chads' after injuries had sidelined Fred Wills and Charlie Oates. Ted's outings came on consecutive nights at Plymouth and Leicester at the end of September 1949 and saw him score his only point at the Blackbird Road track. He continued to ride until the end of the 1951 season, retiring after winning the Charlie Oates Novice Trophy for Liverpool juniors.
