Born: c. 1925, Manchester, Greater Manchester, England.

Mancunian Len was an ex-army dispatch rider and earned positive reviews from Stoke promoter Tiger Stevenson during trials at Sun Street. He scored two points in the 'Potters' first league match of the 1948 season at Wombwell but was replaced by Bert Danner for the next match and never appeared for the club again. He had trials at Yarmouth in 1949 but was unable to break into the side at Caister Road and returned to his first love of road racing, regularly competing in the Isle of Man TT event.
