

PEARCE, James MacMillan (Max)

Born: February 26 1920, Sydney, New South Wales, Australia.

Died: July 14, 1948.

A young Australian from Sydney, Max was given opportunities at Third Division Yarmouth in 1948, after initially signing for their sister track, Norwich. He had little experience in speedway, finding the going tough in his short spell in Britain, and in only his third appearance for the 'Bloaters', at home to Coventry on July 13, he crashed in a second half race and tragically died from a fracture to the base of his skull.
