

**PHILPOTTS, David (Dink)**

A Bournemouth based rider, Dink was one of a number of men with brief speedway experience who were handed trials at Exeter on the advent of Division Three racing at the County Ground. After an injury to Ted Moore in a challenge match, Dink was named in the starting line-up for Exeter's first post-war league match at home to Stoke on May 12, 1947 and rode well to score six, paid seven, from four rides. Despite this promising start, he was to make only two further league appearances and added only two more points to his total.
