

QUICK, Bob

Born: c. 1919, Randfontein, South Africa.

A former road racer, Bob attracted the attention of British promoters in the winter of 1947-48 after beating Wally and Jeff Lloyd in some impressive outings in his native South Africa. He was signed on by Belle Vue and loaned to Edinburgh, but fractured a wrist during an early season outing for the 'Monarchs' at Sheffield. Upon his recovery he had trials at Cradley Heath but a place in the league side was not forthcoming and he returned to his home nation having not made the grade. Bob later became involved in local politics and was mayor at his home town of Randfontein.
