

REVETT, Geoffrey Gerald (Geoff)**Born:** November 1, 1919, Ipswich, Suffolk, England.***Died:** December 1992.

A post-war Norwich product, burly Geoff was a popular figure at The Firs and won a regular team place in 1947. In his final two years for the 'Stars' he averaged over five points per match and was always a useful scorer from a reserve or second string berth, saving his best performances for the National Trophy - scoring paid 13 and paid 14 in successive matches during the 'Stars' cup campaign in 1948. Business interests at his Ipswich motorcycle shop eventually limited his appearances for the club and he retired prematurely from the sport in 1948.
