

RIDDELL, Malcolm**Born:** Scotland.

A Scottish junior, Malcolm rode just twice for Glasgow in the 1949 season, being called upon when the 'Tigers' Australian contingent sailed for home before the completion of the league programme. Failing to score on his debut in the record 14-70 defeat at Bristol, Malcolm opened his account with a point at home to Coventry five days later. He was a popular and successful performer in Belfast in the late 1940s and early 1950s and also had a spell at Motherwell early in 1951 without ever making another league appearance.
