

## SHARPE, Harold

**Born:** January 25, 1916, Kendal, Cumbria, England.\*

A product of the Army tracks in Germany, Harold rode at two of speedway's outposts in 1947 on loan from his parent track, Wembley. His first posting was at Glasgow where he made eight appearances and then at Plymouth, where he became a regular choice in the team. He was expected to continue at the Devon track in 1948 but he left to take over the management of a haulage company and made only one more official outing, an emergency National Trophy appearance for New Cross in 1948 when the 'Rangers' discovered at the last minute that Cyril Roger was cup tied. Harold did sign for Oxford in 1949 but never made an official appearance for the club.
