

SHEARER, Thomas (Bert)

Born: April 19, 1916, Motherwell, Scotland.

Bert was a popular Scottish junior who had his best spell in the sport with Glasgow in 1947, averaging over five points per match that season and fluctuating between a reserve berth and second string role. He started the 1948 season with Edinburgh but struggled at Old Meadowbank, seeing his average dip by around one and a half points per match and ended the season back at Glasgow before retiring at the end of the year.
