

SIVYER, Bob

Bob was a bit part player in Eastbourne's Third Division championship winning side of 1947 but, despite an unbeaten performance from two rides at Plymouth, he was unable to cement his position in the side. He remained with the club when they transferred their operations to Hastings in 1948 and continued to be limited to second half rides in the main, making only nine appearances for the 'Saxons' in a two year spell. After the closure of Hastings, Bob rode several times for Eastbourne in non-league challenge matches.
