

THOMAS, Bernard

Born: September 30, 1913, Sheffield, South Yorkshire, England.*

Died: October, 1991.

A popular figure with his home supporters at Wombwell, Bernard rode for the 'Colliers' in both their post-war seasons and hailed from nearby Sheffield. A regular in 1947, apart from short spells out with injury, he was twice in double figures and was particularly impressive around his home Station Road circuit. However, he struggled badly at the start of 1948 and lost his team place by the end of April. He came back into the side on three separate occasions before the end of the year but was not able to regain his 1947 form.
