

WILLIAMS, William Glyn (Bill)

Born: December 28, 1920, Willesden, London, England.*

Londoner Bill was a post-war junior who travelled to Exeter in 1947 to gain experience and compete for a place in the newly formed Third Division side. He was named in the 'Falcons' line-up for the opening league match of the season and scored five, paid seven, from three rides to ensure his place for the next few meetings. However, he was unable to repeat his debut score and lost his team spot by June. In 1948 Bill, often programmed as Dave Williams, had a spell at Yarmouth which proved to be unsuccessful and he never returned to league racing.
